HOW DO I KNOW IF I HAVE HEATED MIRRORS?

This may or may not surprise you, but some truck owners or drivers already have heated mirrors factory-installed on their vehicles without knowing it.

The heating mechanisms operate behind the glass, making it difficult to recognize at a first glance.

To figure out if you've got a heated or non-heated mirror, look for these telltale signs:

- A heat symbol on the side of the mirror
- Two wires coming out of the back of the mirror these may be used to power the heating mechanism behind the glass
- A pin-striped heating grid behind the mirror glass. Note that you should only check for this if you know how to safely pop the glass pane out and put it back in without cracking it. Otherwise, consult with a technician or mechanic.

If you've got access to your vehicle's user manual, that should also give you information on what kind of mirrors you've got.
